**Treasurer's Report:** Cheryl moved to approve the Treasurer's Report, Betty Seconded

**Committee Reports:** The Trailing Trial to be held on July 31 in conjunction with the 2009 Northwest Regional has been approved. All judges have accepted their positions; Janet Kelly, Suzi, Kim. We will be offering 3 MTs, 2MTIs, 1MTXs. Betty is waiting to decide if any EECTs will be offered. The school has been contacted and has approved letting us use their grounds. Betty is still finalizing the insurance and putting together the estimated expense sheet. We will need to do some fundraising to cover costs. Trophies will be offered.

**Regional Report:** Parade of Hounds report attached. Janis has chosen the trophies and is working on getting this lined up. Raffle flyers attached. Tim and Sheri Whetstine and Betty Seigal are hosting the lunch. We are offering one type of meat this year. Judge's hospitality was discussed. Sonnya will send the Chelan Raffle flyer to Lynn Aguirre and Stacey Poler for publication. Betty will send the Trailing Trial info to Lynne Aguirre and Stacey Poler for publication. Suzi volunteered to get a Ring Steward.

**Rescue Report:** Report attached. Additionally, Sherman was discussed. He has no manners, no training and is very hyper. Without training he will be unadoptable, even though he is quite sweet. Sonnya suggested sending him to the Prison Pet Partnership program at the Stafford Creek Prison in Aberdeen. He would get 24-hour a day training by 2 prisoners for 12 weeks. Sonnya will talk to the director to make sure that PRBR will be able to choose his permanent home. Suzi volunteered to go to the prison and present a seminar to teach the prisoners about the personality of bloodhounds. A motion to send Sherman to the prison was made by Cheryl. It was suggested that they try to get their MT judge-ships by then.

The All Hound Club of Bellingham has formed. They have their AKC license status. Their 1<sup>st</sup> show is Sept 5-6. This is strictly a hound group show. Brian, Spud's handler, is a member. Suzi suggested that we find out if we can make a trophy donation in the name of the club to help make a supported entry. Betty made a motion to donate \$100 to the All Hound Club of Bellevue. This was seconded by Cheryl. It was also discussed to do a congratulatory ad in their catalog for their inaugural show. Suzi is going to check into that. This was also motioned and seconded by the same people.

## Rescue Update

March 21, 2009

**Rosebud:** Rosebud is a sweet, little bloodhound that was surrendered by her owners to a humane society. This was due to the family moving and no fault of Rosebud. She is well-tempered and gets along with other dogs, cats, and children. She is waiting for a family to love.



Rosebud was adopted by the Napier family: Jim, Denise, Piper, Hut, Racer, Aspen, Taffi, and Libbi. This is a very nice family and Rosebud is thrilled to be there.



**Huckleberry:** Huckleberry is a big, beautiful bundle of energy. He was found as a stray. He is approximately 10-months-old and is red. Berry is sweet, sweet, sweet! He walks nicely on a leash and loves everyone--kids, cats, other dogs. He will steal your heart! He is neutered, microchipped, de-wormed, and current on vaccinations.

Huckleberry was adopted by Heather and Dave Richards in Rochester, Washington. They have owned basset hounds for over 40 years. Huckleberry is their first bloodhound and he joins Arthur, Lizzy and the cats and rabbits. They have been taking him to basic obedience classes and have been to one of the NWBSAR workouts.

He was owner-surrendered to a pound-- he's come a long way in a short time and it's obvious that he is a real trooper and very brave and resilient. He will steal your heart! He is house-trained, crate trained and knows how to sit. He is also good with the doggie door. He is neutered, microchipped, de-wormed, and current on vaccinations. Beauford was adopted last night, no update is available yet.

Unfortunately, Beauford's original family decided they wanted him back and has done everything short of criminal harassment to make that happen. This has resulted in a change in policy where every incoming bloodhound will have a name change. We are going to go through the alphabet, starting with "A", which will also quickly give us an idea how many hounds we've taken in during the year. Hopefully, this will prevent people from searching the internet and inadvertently running across their bloodhound.

Sherman arrived in mid March from Multnomah County. He was approximately 2 years old, intact and very active with little to no training. We signed him up for basic manners classes and we walked him 1 hour+ per day in an attempt to tire him out and get him used to interacting with people and other dogs. Unfortunately Sherman had behavioral issues that we could not overcome and he had to be humanely euthanized.
